### Nature of project(s) and skills required:

More frequent and intense extreme events are increasing the workload of humanitarian organizations regarding health, food security, water and sanitation and disaster preparedness and response. The humanitarian sector needs to fundamentally restructure its relationship to predictable climate-related threats, evolving towards knowledge-based entities so they can rapidly and flexibly absorb information about changing risks - and opportunities to intervene.
