Through hands-on experience, participants will teach principles and practices of sustainability to young people in Boulder County schools and beyond. The mission of Teach for Sustainability is to promote environmental stewardship, sustainability, education and scientific achievement by focusing on children's personal connection to nature through sustainable actions.

This internship is designed to provide students with the basic knowledge and skills needed to make the broad concept of sustainability relevant and practical within their schools, homes and communities.
